If we have several that can't attend, we will hold a second meeting within the first week of starting. If you are out of town you will need to arrange a time to meet to do your orientation safety meeting. It is mandatory before your first shift.

***Note: At this time it looks like I will start the schedule this year on June 20, 2024. Yes, that is earlier than recent years, season looks to be ahead of recent years, but this all depends on weather. This does not mean we will start that date.

(Month/Dav) Typical years we start in the last week of June and as late as July 5th. We typically start with return workers and a reduced crew and as berries ripen, we increase the number of workers per day. This also is how the season winds down the end of July or beginning of August and the season usually is wrapping up in the 2nd week of August, with the exception of a few older teens that stay on for blueberries.

Schedule – I prepare the entire schedule before we begin the season. The schedule will be handed out at the Safety-Orientation Meeting. I will be scheduling up to 4 days per week, which is approximately 40 hours.

The average day starts at 8:45am and ends around 7:00pm. This can vary earlier or later, to as late as 8:00pm on occasion. Time varies especially if we have late start due to weather and during peak season. We do not schedule split days or short days. If you need to be off earlier for regularly scheduled events, for example drivers ed, sports practices, etc. those would be days you need to note below as days you can not work. On the occasion that something comes up and you are scheduled for that day, you will need to work that out with the field supervisor so she can cover your entire shift or provide coverage.
